

## FILINGS OF NOTE

- The Building Department received a record **1062 permit applications** in 2018 that included 786 single-family new home starts and 12 commercial permit applications.
- ZONING PETITIONS:** Fifteen (15) new Planned Unit Development (PUD) Districts were adopted in 2018 (Notable: **Wheeler Landing PUD District:** northwest corner of SR 32 and Wheeler Road, over 300 acres including 4 different commercial and mixed use areas, which may include a new YMCA; **Lindley Run PUD District:** 130 single-family detached and 300 attached lots located east of Grassy Branch Road between 191st Street and 196th Street; **Hittle at Thirty One PUD District:** consists of commercial uses including two hotels, a public art plaza, restaurants, and retail establishments at the southwest corner of 191st Street and US 31; **Westfield Playhouse PUD District:** 160-seat theater facility in Downtown Westfield adjacent to City Hall.
- Pro X**, the \$5 million athletic training facility, broke ground on the 68,000 sqft building in June becoming the latest business to make the Grand Park Sports Campus its home.

- Grand Park was proud to host its **inaugural year of Colts Training Camp**. Nearly 40,000 attended the camp with 261 city volunteers, 5,000+ volunteer hours and \$133 million in media value for the city.
- Sports Destination Management, the leading publication for sports event planners and tournament directors, announced the winners of its 2018 Reader's Choice Awards. **Westfield's Grand Park Sports Campus was named a "Favorite Outdoor Venue."**
- Several projects have been completed in the city, such as: Riverview Health Westfield Hospital, Cambria Hotel, Field Brewing, the student-designed Asa Bales playground and the portion of the **Monon Trail connecting Westfield to Sheridan**.


## NOTABLE CD EVENTS
